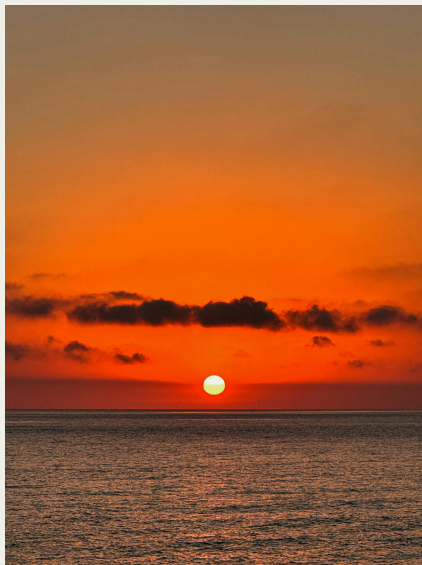


ORILLIA: THE SUNSHINE CITY
